### History

Ukraine International Airlines is Ukraine's leading international carrier. It was founded in 1992. Over the years since its creation UIA has satisfied all of the goals set out in its Foundation documents: to create a modern competitive international Ukrainian airline with high quality standards; to expand relations between Ukraine and foreign countries; to integrate Ukrainian civil aviation industry into the framework of world air transport; to introduce advanced technologies and management; to attract foreign investment; to earn profits.

Ukraine International Airlines was the first airline in CIS to introduce Boeing 737 aircraft. The fleet now consists of 17 airplanes. The Airline links Ukraine with almost 3000 destinations worldwide operating 250 flights weekly.

Today Ukraine International Airlines has more than 40 representative offices in Ukraine and abroad and UIA sales network covers 70 countries worldwide.

UIA has certification to carry out full technical maintenance on B737 aircraft. UIA provides technical maintenance and training to airlines in Ukraine and the region. UIA became the first officially registered IOSA Operator in CIS that has successfully completed the special IATA Operational Safety Audit (IOSA).

Ukraine International Airlines has a subsidiary Ground Handling company – INTERAVIA-SWISSPORT, at Kiev Borispol Airport. UIA also has a subsidiary/partner Panorama Tours (www. panorama-tours.com) selling tourism into Ukraine.
